Fabric Requirements (based on 40" width of fabric)

Lightest Fabric - 4 yards

Accent #1 - 1 yard

Accent #2 - 1 yard

Border - 1-1/2 yards - You may want to purchase this after the quilt top is done

<u>Cutting: All strips are cut selvage to selvage</u>

Lightest Fabric Α Cut 8 strips - 3 5/8"; sub-cut into 72 - 3 5/8" squares; Label A. Cut 4 strips - 7 1/2"; sub-cut into 18 - 7 1/2" squares; R cut squares into triangles as shown; Label B. Cut 4 strips - 4"; sub-cut into 36 - 4" squares; cut squares into 72 triangles as shown; Label C. Cut 2 strips - 4 3/8"; sub-cut into 18 - 4 3/8" squares; cut squares into 72 triangles as shown; Label D. Accent #1 Cut 8 strips 4"; sub-cut into 72 - 4" squares; E cut squares into 144 triangles as shown; Label E. Accent #2 Cut 2 strips - 4 3/8"; sub-cut into 18 - 4 3/8" squares; cut squares into 72 triangles as shown; Label D. Cut 6 strips - 2"; Label Inner Border Border and Binding Cut fabric into 6 - 4 1/2" strips; Label Outer Border Cut fabric into 6 - 2 1/2" strips; Label Binding
