Fabrics	Lap 50" x 60"	Twin 66" x 80"
Background/Sashing	3 yards	5 ¼ yards
Jax	12 colors	14 colors
	1/3 to 3/8 yard each	½ yard each color
Border	1 ¼ yards	1 ½ yards

Note: binding is made with scraps of Jax fabrics

Cutting Instructions:

<b>Background</b>	<u>Lap Size</u>	<u>Twin Size</u>
Cut 8" strips by wof	9	17
Sub-cut into 8" squares	42	80

<b>Sashing</b>		
Cut 1 ½" strips by wof	15	27
Sub-cut into 1 ½" x 7 ¼"	71	135

<b>Jax Fabrics</b>		
Cut 5 ½" strips by wof	2 per color	3 per color
Triangles will be cut in class		

<b>Border</b>		
Cut 5 ½" strips by wof	6	8
Cut 1 ½" strips by wof	2	3
Sub-cut into 1 ½" squares	30	63

### **What to bring to class in Houston**

Thread to blend with background fabric

Basic sewing supplies: pins, scissors, etc.

Rotary cutter and mat

Rulers – 9 ½" square or larger, 60 degree triangle (optional, paper template provided)

Roxanne's Glue Baste-It (optional, but very handy)

Due to weight limitations on airplanes, only bring background squares and Jax fabrics. We will not have time to get into borders and/or sashing.
