

Circle Quilts – Liberty Star Project

When choosing fabrics for this quilt opt for small-scale prints; large scale prints will be lost in this design. Smaller stripes can be used effectively and create movement and add texture to the design



Fabric Requirements

Fabric A: 3/8 yard for center and Ring #1
Fabric B: 1/2 yard for Rings #1 and #2
Fabric C: 7/8 yard for Rings #2 and #3
Fabric D: 1 1/8 yard for Rings #3 and #4
Background: 5/8 yard
Binding: 1/2 yard

Cutting Requirements – cut strips selvage to selvage

Fabric A: Cut 1 – 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square (cut this first)
Cut 2 – 2" strips

Fabric B: Cut 5 – 2 1/2" strips

Fabric C: Cut 6 – 4" strips

Fabric D: Cut 7 – 5" wide strips

Background: Cut 3 – 5" wide strips

Binding: Cut 110" of 2 1/2" bias strips

What to bring to class:

neutral piecing thread; invisible thread – I recommend Superior's New Mono Poly sewing machine with zigzag stitch capability in good working order, with power cord, and foot pedal

Open toed foot or see-through foot and extension table (desirable but not mandatory)

Sharp Needles (size 80) and pins (straight for piece work) and extra bobbins

Scissors – one pair for paper and one pair for fabric/threads

Rotary cutter, cutting ruler (1" x 6" or larger) and mat (9" x 12" or larger)

Seam ripper and tweezers, optional but handy

Spray Sizing or Fabric Finish – I prefer Magic Spray Sizing (can share with friends)

Thread catcher and/or garbage sack

All fabrics pre-cut and labeled as instructed above, plus all the leftovers.

Your copy of *Circle Quilts*, is very handy to have.
