Fabric requirements

Fabric A ¼ yard

Fabric B 5/8 yard

Fabric C 3/4 yard

Fabric D ¾ yard

Fabric E ½ yard

Binding ½ yard



<u>Cutting Instructions</u> – cut selvage to selvage

Fabric A cut 2 – 2 ½" strips for Rings #1 and #2

Fabric B cut 3 – 2 ½" strips for Rings #1 and #2

cut 2 – $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for Ring #3

Fabric C cut 1 – 3" x 3" square for center

Cut 4 – 3" strips for Rings #2 and #3

Cut $2 - 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips for Ring #4

Fabric D cut 5 – 4" strips for Rings #3 and #4

Fabric E cut 2 – 6" strips for Ring #4

Binding cut 110" of 2 ½" bias strips

What to bring to class:

neutral piecing thread; invisible thread – I recommend Superior's New Mono Poly sewing machine with zigzag stitch capability in good working order, with power cord, and foot pedal. Open toed foot or see-through foot and extension table (desirable but not mandatory). Sharp Needles (size 80) and pins (straight for piece work). Extra bobbins.

Scissors – one pair for paper and one pair for fabric/threads

Rotary cutter, cutting ruler (1" x 6" or larger) and mat (9" x 12" or larger)

Seam ripper

Tweezers, optional but handy

Spray Sizing or Fabric Finish – I prefer Magic Spray Sizing (can share with friends) Thread catcher and/or garbage sack

All fabrics cut and labeled as outlined above and all leftovers.

Your copy of *Circle Quilts*, is very handy to have.
